My dear friend,

Can you believe that it is already March? We are one quarter of the way through 2010. Opportunities for ministry are escalating! God is answering so many prayers and opening so many doors and providing so many miracles that I am astounded.

A few weeks ago I was on tour with the Department of Homeland Security, ministering to the Coast Guard, in the Houston/Galveston sector and other points in between. It was remarkable! From there I went on tour with the Pacific Command of the United States Army, Tripler Army Medical Center, and the 25th Infantry Division in Hawaii. This is the same division that I interacted with on two of my tours to Iraq. I was able to spend quality time encouraging them while they were in combat. What a privilege it was to minister to them at home and hear their stories of victory.

Foundations are being poured, and building crews are restoring the existing facilities in Texas making ready for wounded warriors from Brooke Army Medical Center and other military installations in Texas, while our staff in Colorado is preparing to receive wounded warriors from Fort Carson. Do you realize how much you accomplish when you support this ministry? No one will ever be able to point an accusing finger of inactivity at this ministry. **In fact, many have advised me to slow down, warning that I am burning the candle at both ends. I choose to believe that I am twice as bright!** It is hard for me to rest knowing that our young heroes are paying so great a price. I want to do all that I can to assist them in every way possible.

Eagles Summit Ranch in Colorado continues to startle a community of civilians, as well as, participating military organizations that send wounded warriors to our facilities. People are startled because it began as a simple idea and is now a full-blown accomplishment. As I promised from day one, we would not borrow money to operate Eagles Summit Ranch. (The only monies that were borrowed accommodated transactions through banks and title companies and were almost immediately repaid.) The Colorado ranch is scheduled for 2010. We simply notify the leadership of the wounded warrior battalions, offer the dates and it is immediately filled. The same awaits us upon completion of the Texas ranch. As soon as the construction is finished, I believe, we will immediately be out of room, again! The need is so overwhelming!

God has prepared me for a lifetime to accomplish His goals — to instruct our young wounded warriors, teach them and prepare them to stand before an audience and share their stories of tragedy and triumph that will change a nation and revolutionize the spiritual depression that has settled into our homeland. The long-term effects of this effort are proven by an experience told to me this past week by one of the top military commanders in the US Army. Some thirty years ago, when he was seventeen years old, he attended a youth camp where I spoke. By God's special touch during my presentation, his life was changed. He made a commitment to follow after the heart of God. He was also impressed to join the military. Today he has three stars on his insignia (a lieutenant general) and commands tens of thousands of troops. How many more stories like this can be told as these who are being trained at Eagles Summit Ranch multiply the effort, exponentially!

On many occasions I have expressed my fear of causing you to go through burnout with my repeated requests for funding. Please do not be offended. A wounded warrior will never be charged to come to Eagles Summit Ranch and receive spiritual healing, hope and training for their future. *It has already cost them an arm and a leg.* But, you are not ignorant to the fact that it takes dollars to build the facilities and run the programs. That is why I appeal to you and seek your help on their behalf.

As I wrote several months ago and as many of the military commanders I work with tell me, we are just getting started in Afghanistan. The military hospitals will be filled again with wounded soldiers until our troops can break the strongholds of the enemy. I truly believe you are as aware as I, that there is no visible end in sight to the war on terror. At present, very few casualties are coming from Iraq, but Afghanistan has many sad unfoldings yet to appear. Like a soldier wounded on the battlefield cries out for a medic, our heroes desperately need a caring nation to step up to the plate. This cannot be accomplished by my ministry alone. We all must do our part. Please go the second mile. Help me finish the ranch in Texas, not only debt free, but as quickly as possible. Our heroes are waiting for their new beginning. Help me help them! Send the best gift you can.

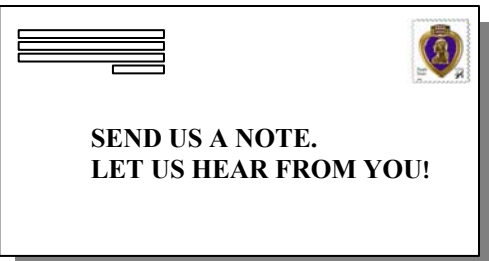
This month he will be speaking in high schools in Ohio. Please pray for him.
